

Inventory list of Accession 04-14: Papers of William E. Biederwolf, 1894-1895, n.d.

A New Testament, published by Samuel Bagster and Sons of London, no date. 188 pages, plus maps and a Harmony of the Four Evangelists. The Book has AW.E. Biederwolf@ stamped on the front cover and has many handwritten notes throughout, apparently by Biederwolf. The title page is loose.

Thesis by William Biederwolf, done at Princeton Seminary, AA Critical Comparison of the Self-Testimony of Jesus in the Synoptists and John@ April 1, 1895. 161 pages. Front and back covers are detached.

Notebook of 180 pages containing a handwritten essay by William Biederwolf on Colossians 2 and 3:1-4 as part of his course work at Princeton Seminary. Also in the notebook is a letter dated April 23, 1894, informing Biederwolf that the essay had won the Maitland Prize and a small notebook that contains the conclusion of the essay.
