Correspondence of Harold and Lucinda Wik; several dozen letters, 1937-1982. All letters have had holes punched in the side for storage in a notebook.

6 typed sermon outlines by Harold Wik and others, 1967-1976, n.d.

Cassette tapes of Harold Wik=s sermons at Berachah Church, Cheltenham, Pennsylvania; December 10, 1995 and January 19, 1997

Hymnal in Chinese, name of Harold Wik on flyleaf. Last page, contain bibliographic information, torn away. Black covers.

Brown covered spiral notebook belonging to Lucinda Wik, containing handwritten Bible verses, sermon outlines, thoughts on a variety of topics. Ca. 1982.

Blue covered spiral notebook of Lucinda Wik=s, contain her handwritten record of the Bible verses she studied each day. 1993-1995.

Black covered notebook, belonging to Harold Wik. Covers have become detached. Contains his handwritten sermon notes, reflections on scripture passages, thoughts on a variety of topics. 1999-2001

Account book of Harold Wik, apparently lists expenses and income related to his work as a colporteur in western Malaysia. 1975-1982.
