

Accession 13-10: Papers of Willis Daniels Lowe, 1924-1935; 1938, 1996

Scrapbook belonging to Ethelind D. Lowe, of b & w photos, clippings, postcards, and other ephemera, most relating to Paul Rader and the Chicago Gospel Tabernacle. There are numerous loose photos and clippings tucked into the book and many pages on which items have fallen off or been removed. Ca. 1927-1932.

Folder with loose clippings and 22 b & w photos, 1923-1935. A few are clippings of poems with notes in red ink that possibly refer to Ethelind Lowe=s suicide. Photos from Niagra Falls, Minneapolis, Lake Harbor. Clipping of an editorial from the London *Daily Mail* about a speech by Adolph Hitler, dated May 22, 1935, with a faint note in red pencil, AI thought this quite true. Please save for me.@ Written on the folder is a note by David Lowe.

Folder of 9 photographs, one in color, a 1928 letter written by Willis Lowe to Paul Rader, a cradle row certificate for Willis Lowe, and a Salvation Army certificate for Willis Lowe. The photos all appear to be of Willis Lowe, his mother Ethelind and other unidentified people. 1924-1996. The folder has written on it a note by David Lowe and his father and grandmother and Paul Rader.
