- Three ring leather notebook with handwritten lectures notes, start with "The Church A Missionary Institution," n.d.
- Notebook with lightbrown covers containing two pages in Chinese and moe handwritten notes on the first fifteen chapters of the book of Acts. Several pages are cut out, n,d,
- Notebook with marbled covers containing hand written notes for the training class lectures, Hanchow. 1900
- Loose pages tied together with string contain typed notes for a General Missions class, 1925
- Loose pages held together with a spring clip contain notes for lectures and pasted on clippings about China Inland Mission's work; the first lecture is "Abounding Oppertunities – Desperate Need," ca. 1946
- Student Notwebook containg Bible class studies whoch Glover did I Huchang. Handwritten notes in Chinese and English. First study is on I. Corinthians
- Marbled covered notebook missing the front cover containing handwrnitten Bible readings and notes in English and Chinese, made in Macao, 1895
- Three ring binder containing typed and handwritten notes for lectures or aticles on significant Protestant missionaries, Raymond Lull, Barholomew Ziegenbalg, Christian Frederick Swartz, Ciunt von Zinzendorf, John Eliot, William Carey, Adoniran Judson, Robert Morrison, David Livingstone, Alexander MacKay, John Williams, Hudson Taylor; n.d.
- Student and Reproter's Notebook contain handwritten notes for lextures on the book of Exodus, n.d.
- Three ring notebook containing several handwrttien lecutres, the first of whch is titled "The Missionary Idea in the Old Testamtn,"ca. 1937
- Small address book with handwritten addresses, held together with a spring clip, ca. 1927
- Small printed book in Chinese with the inscriptin, "To Dear Brither R. H. Glover with Christian greetings from S. L. Hess," 1897
- Small notebook in which are listed alphabetically by hand the name towns and cities throughout the United States, along with the year in Which Gloser spoke there and athe deatials onthe talk he gave; ca. 1947
- Small notebook with tan and red covers, held together with a sping clip. Contains hotes for a variety of talks on different subjects and on a trip to England; ca. 1911
- Small memorandum book held together with a spring clip containing hotes for varipus talks, addresses, expenses for trips, including a trip to China; ca. 1938-1946
- Scrapbook, in very poor condition with no binding, contain articles and poems by Glover in a variety of publications and tracts, 1915-1941
- The Presbyterian Record*, November 1936, containg the obituary for Jonathan Goforth. Loose in the magaizne are several newspaper clippings with obituaries of Goforth
