

Acc. 94-43 inventory: Trans World Radio Video Description Sheet

1. (1952) **Banderilla** (42:00) – created in film. Produced in 1952; director is Irvin Shortus Yeaworth (creator of the film, Creature from the Black Lagoon); story takes place in Seville, Spain. A Protestant's family suffers persecution in Catholic Seville. Through one man's faith, another man commits himself to the Gospel. This film was produced to raise funds for the Tangier station. Dr. Freed carried this movie from church to church across the country in the early days of the ministry (1953-58). It was an international festival winner in the religious category during a Christian film industry competition in the 1960s. ½ VHS, color.
2. (1959) **Red Night** (29:00) – created in film. Produced in 1959 by David Ferrin; story takes place outside Moscow in the late 1950s; it is a docudrama about a sister and brother who are university students and are living together, she is a Christians who listens to TWR's broadcasts from Monte Carlo, and he is a atheist and intellectual who eschews Christianity. Dr. Freed makes a brief appearance. There are numerous news clips of life in Russia after World War II. It is a very moving and convincing story of life in atheistic Russia. ½ VHS, color.
3. (1993) **Church Starting** (9:58) – produced by KMA, Dallas, from miscellaneous TWR footage and specifically highlights India, Africa, Europe, Latin America; video subject is how TWR plants or starts churches around the world through the radio broadcasts. ½ VHS, color.
4. (1994) **Voices in the Air** (9:06) – produced by KMA, Dallas; video subject is TWR's 40th anniversary of first Gospel broadcast and TWR's present radio ministry around the world. ½" VHS, partial color, partial black and white.
