Biographical and informational notes from Phil Dow:

- Tape 1 ADoc@ Propst was the child of RVA=s second teacher, Miss Myers, and a student at RVA from 1916-1928, and returned to Kenya as a missionary doctor and served on RVA=s school board. He was interviewed at Media, Florida on August 9, 1997
 Clara Barret served at RVA as the school=s first librarian. The current library is named The Clara Barret Library in her honor. She was interviewed at Media, Florida on August 9, 1997
- Tape 2 Speech by Shel Arensen was given to the students and faculty of RVA upon commencement of the Stanley and Livingstone House Games in 1997.
- Tape 3 & 4 Dr. Bill Barnett was a student at RVA in the late 1920s and early 1930s and served as the Kijabe Doctor from 1963-1980. He was interviewed at the home of Ted Barnett in Pearl River New York on June 30, 1998.
- Tape 5 Charles Skoda was a student at RVA from 1943-1954 and was interviewed at Buck Creek Camp, Washington state on May 29, 1999.
